Volunteers Urgently Needed for the Following Positions:

Shelter Service Associate

In-person shelter support to assist with reception, registration, feeding, dormitory, information collection, and other vital tasks to help those we serve.

Disaster Action Team Responder

Assist local individuals and families in-person and virtually who have been impacted by a home fire or local other disaster.

Disaster Health Services

Health professionals are needed in shelters both virtually or inperson to provide hands-on care, health education, health assessments, and additional health-related support.

Disaster Caseworker

Support recovery by connecting directly with clients both in-person or virtually to provide advocacy, referrals and financial assistance though the Red Cross case management system.
