II. Review of Previous Minutes (October 7, 2025)

- Minutes from the October 7, 2025 meeting were reviewed and approved.

III. PY25 PYC Report & Dashboard Update

Presented by: Ann Marie Baker

Ann Marie provided an overview of PY25 performance and activity, including:

- New enrollments and active caseload
- Number of follow-up participants
- Work experience placements
- Credentials earned
- Career Smart classes conducted
- Financial updates on staff, operations, and training expenditures

The committee expressed strong support for Ann Marie's leadership and the progress made following the transition from the previous Program Manager.

IV. March Meeting Date

- The scheduled March 3rd meeting conflicts with the SETA conference and spring break periods.
- Jennifer Campbell offered to hold the meeting remotely; however, the committee opted to identify an alternative date.

Action: The March meeting will be rescheduled based on availability determined through electronic voting.

V. Executive Session

- The committee entered executive session to discuss sensitive matters, likely related to RFP planning and provider performance.

Action Taken: Motion to exit executive session by Kristy, second by Jeromy. Passed with no opposition.

VI. New Business

A. Combining Adult & Youth RFPs

- The committee discussed combining the Adult and Youth Operator grants into a single RFP with separate scopes of work.
- Benefits highlighted included increased efficiency, reduced administrative burden, and positive experiences with current providers.
- Concerns regarding potential performance decline were addressed, with a reminder that WorkLink conducts annual contract extensions and may terminate for lack of performance.

Action Taken: Motion by Kristy to combine the 2026 Adult and Youth Operator grants into one RFP; second Jeromy. Passed unanimously.

B. Electronic RFP Submissions

- Victoria Britton proposed adopting electronic submission of RFPs to improve timestamp accuracy, efficiency, and workflow.
- Staff will review platform options and consider technical factors such as file sizes and firewalls.







Dialing 7-1-1 & Text Telephones (TTYs)

The SC Office of Regulatory Staff (ORS) administers the Telecommunications Relay Service in South Carolina. Offered at no charge to the public, these services were established to better meet the needs of South Carolina citizens who have trouble hearing or speaking on the phone. 7-1-1 is a telephone relay number that connects typical (voice) telephone users with individuals who use text telephones (TTYs).

Speech-to-Speech (STS) Relay Service:	Relay South Carolina (RSC):
This service aids those who have a problem being understood due to speech impairment (such as may result from a stroke, throat surgery, or other condition).	This service assists those who are deaf or hard of hearing and use TTY/TDD (Text Telephone or Telecommunications Devices for the Deaf) to communicate.

Both services are available to anyone in the state for business or personal use. There is no limit to the number of times the service can be used or to the length of time for each call. The service can assist both English and Spanish speaking persons. Should a long-distance call be required to reach one of the parties, a discounted long-distance rate will be charged.

How These Services Work

STS Relay Service employs trained operators who can assist in interpreting what the person with a speech disability is saying and relay the information. The caller dials 7-1-1 and provides the phone number of the person that the caller is trying to contact. The operator makes the call and remains on the line to assure the conversation is fully understood on both ends.

RSC uses trained operators who convert a voice message into typed text messages or a typed text message into a voice message. As with STS, the caller dials 711 (or 1-800-735-2905 for intrastate and 1-800-877-8973 for interstate) and provides the number of the person the caller is trying to contact. The operator will make the call and will remain on the line to provide the literal translation.

Third-Party Language Access Service Providers and Instructions

The State Fiscal Accountability Authority (SFAA) contracts with service providers for state use annually. For contract details and price lists, go to <https://procurement.sc.gov/contracts>, select “Goods & Services Contract Search,” and scroll down to “On-Demand Interpreting and Translation Services.” DEW’s Office of Equal Opportunity (EO) renews purchase order numbers as contracts are created or renewed. Preferred vendors and current purchase order numbers are provided below. Staff must write the purchase order numbers on invoices and on the DEW Language Access Services Usage Form (available on the Employment Services DEWConnect Page) for verification, tracking, and recordkeeping.

For questions or concerns about using vendor services or the quality of vendor services, contact EO at OEO@dew.sc.gov.
For urgent situations, staff should contact their regional manager and/or area director immediately to ensure the situation is addressed timely.

In-Person vs Virtual Interpretation Services – Timely and free language access services are key to equitable service provision for LEP individuals. Generally, in-person interpretation services are most effective because the interpreter can observe body language and other non-verbal cues; however, to ensure timely access to interpretation services, it is sometimes more practical to use over-the-phone interpreting (OPI) or video-remote interpreting (VRI). Situations that warrant pursuing in-person interpretation include situations where access to wireless data and/or internet is unreliable and large events where OPI and VRI would be impractical. If staff is concerned about the effectiveness of OPI or VRI, staff should reach out to their Regional Manager or Area Director for further guidance. Whenever possible, staff should seek a private space to utilize language access services in order to protect PII and to remove distractions.

Over-the-Phone Interpreting (OPI) and Video-Remote Interpreting (VRI) – If no staff-interpreter is available for in-person service provision, OPI and VRI are the next best and most expedient options for providing services. VRI is available on-demand on devices that are connected to the internet with audio visual capabilities, such as laptops, smartphones, tablets, and desktops.

Translation Instructions for DEW Websites

Google Translate drives the translation feature on DEW online sites to include SC Works Online Services (SCWOS). To access language translation on DEW web pages, follow these steps:

DEW Website (dew.sc.gov)

Step 1. Log in through Microsoft Edge or Google Chrome internet browser.

Step 2. Enter the DEW website address: dew.sc.gov.

Step 3. Directly above the search feature, click “? Translate.”

NOTE: The website defaults to Spanish, and the Google Translate tagline appears.

Step 4. Select the drop-down arrow next to the “Google Translate” tagline feature.

NOTE: A list of available languages will appear.

Step 5. Select the customer’s language.

NOTE: The entire page will be translated to the chosen language.

To access another language repeat steps 4 and 5.

SCWOS (jobs.scworks.org)

Step 1. Log in through a Microsoft Edge or Google Chrome internet browser.

Step 2. Right click on the page.

Step 3. On the popup menu, select “Translate to Spanish.”

Step 4. In the menu bar, select the link to the Google Translate icon.

Step 5. Select the 3 dots icon.

Step 6. Select “Choose Another Language”

Step 7. In the “Language to Translate to” box select the language your customer speaks. The entire site will display in the customers language.

SC Works Website (scworks.org)

Step 1. Log in through Google Chrome internet browser (this feature will not work using Microsoft Edge).

Step 2. Right click on the page.

Step 3. On the popup menu, select "Translate to English."

Step 4. In the menu bar at the top of the screen, select the link to the Google Translate icon.

Step 5. Select the 3 dots icon.

Step 6. Select "Choose Another Language."

Step 7. In the "Language to Translate into" box select the language your customer speaks. The entire site will display in the customer's language.
